January Heritage Preservation Office Report

Purpose

A report to advise the PACAC on the monthly activities of the Heritage Preservation Office (HPO) for the months of December and January of 2020/2021.

Budget and Financial Implications

There are no budgetary or financial implications associated with the recommendation.

Background

Doors Open 2020/21 – Doors Open Peterborough created a digital program for 2020/2021. The Steering Committee created video content with a local media company to produce videos of select sites and one digital walking tour of the downtown core.

Young Canada Works –The HPO has secured funding for a 3-month contract for a student to work on research in preparation for a future Heritage Conservation District. Application is being made to the program for a number of summer students to support HPO operations for the summer.

Heritage Conservation District Signage – The HPO has installed a mockup of signage in the Avenues & Neighbourhood Heritage Conservation District. Feedback was solicited from the neighbourhood and staff are currently reviewing the responses and considering next steps.

Hunter Street Bridge 100th Anniversary – To commemorate the 100th anniversary of the completion of the Hunter Street Bridge on August 2, 2021, The Trent Valley Archives is producing a commemorative booklet and a video in partnership with YourTV. TVA approached the City to ask if it is interested in hosting an event on the day. The PACAC is being asked to consider it is interested in undertaking the event.
