DIRECTOR RECOMMENDATIONS

The City of Peterborough Holdings. Inc. (COPHI) Board and its Governance and Nominating Committee are making two recommendations for Council approval:

- 1) That Mr. Derek Nice be appointed to the COPHI Board for a three-year term expiring December 31, 2023;
