**East City School Project - Update** 

### **Purpose**

A report to advise Committee that the Museum Director will provide an update regarding the East City School Project.

# **Budget and Financial Implications**

There are no immediate budget or financial implications associated with the recommendation.

## **Background**

The Kawartha Pine Ridge District School Board (KPRDSB) acquired 1.9 acres of Peterborough Museum & Archives (PMA) property to accommodate the construction of

a new East City school and associated bus access. Construction commenced in June 2019.

#### **Impact on Facilities and Collection**

PMA and KPRDSB staff identified six (6) primary risks to the PMA facilities and collection during the East City School construction project: (1) Museum Drive access; (2) Site vandalism; (3) Power outage; (4) Vibration; (5) Increased dust; and, (6) Increased pest ingress. Refer to MAAC20-002 for details.

PMA and KPRDSB staff are working together to mitigate these risks and the associated impacts on PMA service delivery, collection care, access and safety.

## **Summary**

The Kawartha Pine Ridge District School Board (KPRDSB) and the City of Peterborough are united in the goal to develop a positive East City community.
