## **Background**

The 2021 Public Art Program priorities consist of four projects designed to enhance our civic spaces, support services and programs across the corporation, and promote economic development.

Developed in collaboration with Infrastructure, Transportation and Planning the **Road Mural Project** will encourage active transportation and ensure responsible navigation of public spaces during the pandemic recalibration.

The Artist Garden Project is a pilot Public Art for Community Project (PARC) to test the potential for a new public art platform to activate the Urban Park.

Developed in partnership with Transportation and Sponsorship the **Transit Stop Shelter Project** will turn bus shelters across the City into Public Art Platforms for the temporary display of text-based works and/ or visual art.

The Art for Sustainability Advancement Project (ASAP) is two phase project that provides the framework and funding for artists in the community to participate in municipal environment, climate change and sustainability planning in phase 1, and to realize an innovative low-impact public art project in phase 2 (2022).
