Presentation on Heritage Conservation Districts

Purpose

A report to provide the Peterborough Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee (PACAC) with an overview of the process for creating a Heritage Conservation District (HCD).

Budget and Financial Implications

There are no budgetary or financial implications associated with the recommendation.

Background

Conservation districts have been used traditionally in Ontario to protect large areas of heritage resources which are defined by a common history. In 2016 Council adopted the Heritage Conservation District Plan and By-law creating the Avenues and Neighbourhood heritage conservation district, composed of approximately 360 properties. In the 2021 budget, Council allocated \$100,000 for the completion of a Heritage Conservation District Study for the core area of the City.

Heritage Preservation Staff will provide the PACAC with an overview presentation of the process for creating an HCD and the opportunities and challenges involved.
