Purpose

Budget and Financial Implications

Background

Doors Open and Heritage Hunt 2021 – Jessica Bisson the coordinator for Doors Open Peterborough and the Heritage Hunt will provide an update on the status of both programs.

Young Canada Works –The HPO was awarded two additional summer student grant positions but was unable to fill them. Staff are working with YCW to see if the funding for the summer student positions could be converted to a second intern position. Interviews for the internship the City has already received will be held in early September.

National Trust Conference – The National Trust Conference for 2021 is again being held virtually from September 28 to October 1, 2021. The theme for the conference is “Heritage and the Global Reset: Seizing the Moment” and focuses on three areas where heritage can have a profound effect on issues dominating world agendas as we come out of the pandemic:

Environmental Reset: Asserting Conservation as Climate & Consumption Solution

Social & Cultural Reset: Changing the Narrative & Expanding Relevance

Economic Reset: Practice, Planning, & Transforming the Marketplace
