

Public Notice Surplus of City-Owned Property

Take Notice that, pursuant to By-law 95-62, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Peterborough has declared that a piece of municipally owned property known as **729 Park Street South, Peterborough (formerly the Dela Fosse Library)** is surplus to its needs and at its meeting, to be held electronically, through the City's website (www.peterborough.ca) at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, July 25, 2022, intends to pass a by-law to authorize the sale of the land.

And Further Take Notice that at the said meeting Council shall hear in person or by their Counsel, Solicitor or Agent any person who claims that they would be prejudicially affected by the by-law and who applies to be heard. Additionally, any person may make written or verbal representation either in support of or in opposition to the sale of the municipal property as follows:

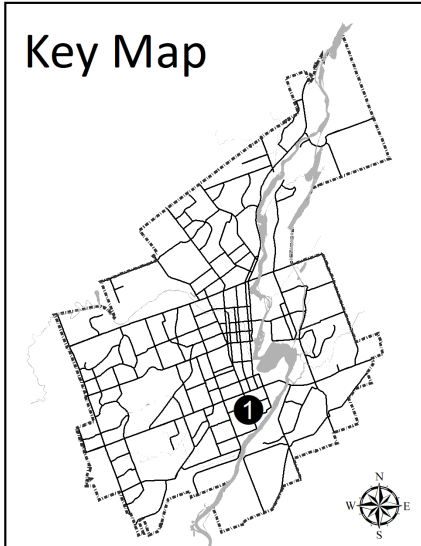

- b) Written submissions must be received by 11:00 a.m. the day of the meeting either by mail, by dropping off to the City's drop box located outside the main entrance to City Hall, 500 George Street North, or by email to Clerks@peterborough.ca (please quote the property address).

Please note that unregistered delegations are not permitted.
