

The Corporation of the City of Peterborough

By-Law Number 23-083

Being a By-law to authorize the 2023 portion of the Infrastructure and Planning Services Property Upgrades at an estimated cost of \$675,000 and the issuing of tax-supported debentures to a maximum of \$200,000 to finance the work

Whereas at its January 30, 2023 meeting, Council adopted the 2023 Capital Budget which included project number 3-1.03 in the amount of \$475,000 for the 2023 portion of the Infrastructure and Planning Services Property Upgrades;

And Whereas at its August 28, 2023 meeting, Council approved Report CLSFM23-030 reassigning \$200,000 uncommitted capital funding from the Simcoe Street Parking Garage Rehabilitation project to King Street Parkade Elevator Replacement project;

And Whereas \$200,000 of the total \$675,000 cost of the 2023 portion of the Infrastructure and Planning Services Property Upgrades (King Street Parkade Elevator Replacement project) is to be financed from tax-supported debentures;

And Whereas the Treasurer has calculated an updated limit for the Corporation of the City of Peterborough, using the most recent financial debt and obligation limit determined by the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing, in accordance with the provisions of Ontario Regulation 403/02 (the limit);

And Whereas the Treasurer has calculated the estimated annual amount payable in respect of a portion of the capital work described in this by-law, to be financed by debenture and has determined that such estimated annual amount payable will not cause the Corporation's total annual debt repayment to exceed the limit;

Now Therefore, The Corporation of the City of Peterborough by the Council thereof hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That the 2023 portion of the Infrastructure and Planning Services Property Upgrades proceed at an estimated cost of \$675,000; and
- 2. That tax-supported debentures be issued, to a maximum of \$200,000 for a term not to exceed twenty years, to finance the 2023 portion of the work.
