Subject

A report to provide a presentation to the Arenas, Parks, and Recreation Advisory Committee on the City of Peterborough Cycling Master Plan.

Recommendation

That the Arenas, Parks, and Recreation Advisory Committee approve the recommendation outlined in Report APRAC24-002, dated February 27, 2024, of the Transportation Demand Management Planner as follows:

That the presentation by the Transportation Demand Management Planner on the City of Peterborough Cycling Master Plan be received for information.

Background

In 2022, Council approved an update to the City of Peterborough Transportation Master Plan. This Master Plan contains several supplemental documents that were prepared concurrently as feeder studies to the larger Master Plan. One of those documents is the Cycling Master Plan, a 20-year plan offering a long-term vision and detailed set of recommendations to move Peterborough towards the Transportation Master Plan target of achieving 25% active transportation mode share.

The Master Plans were carried out under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process for Master Plan projects. Final stages of these processes were completed in 2023, and the City is now moving forward with implementation.

The presentation to the Arenas, Parks, and Recreation Advisory Committee will provide an overview of the City's Cycling Master Plan and highlight recommendations that feature connections to parks and recreation facilities and initiatives.

Strategic Plan

Strategic Priority Pillar – Community & Wellbeing

The Community & Well-being Pillar reads, “Foster community resiliency, neighbourhood identity, civic pride, sense of belonging, and inter-cultural harmony. Enhance and protect the health, safety, and well-being of all our City. Provide robust, affordable, and accessible sport, recreation, wellness, arts, and social programs for people of all ages and abilities.” The Cycling Master Plan aligns with several pillar priorities, including those addressing safe neighbourhoods, multi-modal transportation, and traffic safety.
