Background

Peterborough Museum & Archives: Mandate

As part of the collective memory of the community, the Peterborough Museum & Archives preserves, presents, and promotes the heritage and culture of Peterborough

and area and provides significant heritage programs for the education and enjoyment of both visitors and residents alike.

Peterborough Museum & Archives: Vision

Preserving and celebrating the collective memories of our community ~ stories, images and traces of the people and the land.

Peterborough Museum & Archives (PMA): 5 Year Plans

- a) In 2012, the Museum & Archives Advisory Committee approved the PMA 5 Year Plan: Accommodation Objectives 2012 to 2017 (MAAC12-005).
- b) In 2018, the Museum & Archives Advisory Committee approved the updated PMA 5 Year Plan: Accommodation Objectives 2018 to 2023 (MAAC18-008).

A review in 2024 is timely and necessary.
