## **Purpose**

## **Budget and Financial Implications**

There are no budgetary or financial implications associated with the recommendation.

## Background

**Doors Open:** Doors Open Peterborough took place on Saturday May 5<sup>th</sup> with the theme “Peterborough Works: Industry Past and Present.” The event recorded approximately 2,400 site visits with particularly strong turn-outs at the London Street Generating Station and the Mattress Factory. A significant number of surveys were collected from visitors and will be analyzed in the coming weeks to assist in the planning for Doors Open Peterborough 2019.

**Heritage Hunt:** The 2018 Heritage Hunt was published in the Peterborough Examiner on Thursday, April 5, 2018. The final date for submission of answer sheets was Friday, May 11. A total of 29 answer sheets were submitted by both individuals and groups. The winners have been identified and will be recognized in the Peterborough Examiner.

**2019 Budget:** The preliminary budgets for the City have been submitted. No new programs or positions are being considered and increases will be capped at 2.5%.

**Official Plan Design Charrette:** Staff and members of City advisory committees participated in a four day design workshop to develop content regarding intensification of the downtown, transportation corridors and nodes with development potential.

**Archaeology Map Update:** A capital allocation request has been made as part of the 2019 budget submission to update the archaeology prediction model. This would include repairing some errors in existing data and adding new data sets that have been assembled in the last 6 years since the model was first put in to use.
