

## **General Committee Report No. 15 Meeting of June 6, 2018**

**To the Council of The City of Peterborough for consideration at its meeting held July 9, 2018**

**The General Committee as a result of its special meeting held on June 6, 2018 recommends as follows:**

### **1. Social Housing Apartment Improvement Program Report IPSHD18-003**

That Council approve the recommendations outlined in Report IPSHD18-003 dated June 6, 2018, of the Commissioner of Infrastructure and Planning Services, as follows:

- a) That the City of Peterborough participate in the Social Housing Apartment Improvement Program, offered by the Province of Ontario, for specific eligible repairs and retrofits at high-rise social housing apartments;
- b) That the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to execute Transfer Payment Agreements with the Ministry of Housing for the Social Housing Apartment Improvement Program; and
- c) That the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to execute funding and other associated agreements with eligible social housing providers, with terms and conditions satisfactory to the City Solicitor, or designate.

### **2. Subdivision Assumption of Municipal Road and all Works, Lands and Services within Subdivision Plan 45M-235 Report IPEC18-015**

That Council approve the recommendations outlined in Report IPSEC18-015, dated June 6, 2018, of the Commissioner of Infrastructure and Planning Services as follows:

- a) That Hendricks Subdivision be assumed in accordance with the terms of the Subdivision Agreement registered as Instrument PE173359 for Plan 45M-235 dated May 9, 2012 between the City of Peterborough and 1827403 Ontario Inc.; and
- b) That Council approve the By-law attached as Appendix A to Report IPSEC18-015 to formally assume responsibility for the services installed within Plan 45M-235 and assume the associated operations, maintenance and capital reconstruction costs thereof.

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**3. Status of 2012 Comprehensive Transportation Master Plan Recommendations**  
**Report IPSTR18-015**

That Council approve the recommendation outlined in Report IPSTR18-015, dated June 6, 2018, of the Commissioner of Infrastructure and Planning Services, as follows:

That the presentation by Kevin Jones, Manager Transportation, and Report IPSTR18-015 Status of 2012 Transportation Master Plan Recommendations, be received for information.

**4. Enacting New Smoking and Appointment By-laws**  
**Report CLSOCS18-004**

That Council approve the recommendations outlined in Report CLSOCS18-004 dated June 6, 2018, of the Commissioner of Corporate and Legislative Services, as follows:

- a) That Smoking By-law 16-021 be repealed and replaced with the By-law attached as Appendix A.
- b) That Appointment By-law 18-004 be repealed and replaced with the By-law attached as Appendix B.

At the meeting of June 6, 2018, Committee added item c) as follows:

- c) That the draft by-law attached to Report CLSOCS18-004 be amended by adding the following new section 2.7 as follows:

"2.7 No person shall smoke or hold a lighted Tobacco Product or Medical Cannabis or use an Electronic Cigarette, e-substance, or Vapour Product within or upon any portion of a public road allowance which has been closed in accordance with a road closure permit issued by the City Clerk's office."

**5. Sidewalk Strategic Plan Update**  
**Report IPSTR18-013**

That Council approve the recommendation outlined in Report IPSTR18-013, dated June 6, 2018, of the Commissioner of Infrastructure and Planning Services, as follows:

That Report IPSTR18-013 Sidewalk Strategic Plan Update be received for information.

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**6. Hunter Street East / Armour Road Traffic Operational Review**  
**Report IPSTR18-012**

That Council approve the recommendations outlined in Report IPSTR18-012 dated June 6, 2018, of the Commissioner of Infrastructure and Planning Services, as follows:

- a) That Countdown Pedestrian Signals, Ladder Crosswalk pavement markings, and a Leading Pedestrian Interval be implemented at the intersection of Hunter Street East and Armour Road; and

At the meeting of June 6, 2018 Committee amended item b) as follows:

- b) That a 40 km/h speed limit be implemented on Hunter Street East between Rogers Street and Burnham Street.
