Manufacturer's Limited Liquor Sales Licence
Black's Distillery
99 Hunter Street East, Peterborough

Purpose

A report to recommend that Council pass a resolution in support of the application by Black's Distillery, 99 Hunter Street East, for a Manufacturer's Limited Liquor Sales Licence (By the Glass).

Recommendation

That Council approve the recommendation outlined in Report CLSCLK18-016, dated August 20, 2018 of the Commissioner of Corporate and Legislative, as follows:

That The Corporation of the City of Peterborough supports the application of Black's Distillery, for a Manufacture's Limited Liquor Sales Licence (By the Glass).

Budget and Financial Implications

There are no budget or financial implications associated with the recommendation in this report.

Background

Effective May 27, 2007, the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) started accepting applications from Ontario wineries and breweries for a type of licence, which would allow the manufacturer to sell and serve their product to patrons for consumption in single servings at their manufacturing site. The purpose of the “By the Glass” licence is to promote the manufacturer’s product, provide an enhanced tourist experience, or fulfill an educational purpose. It allows a manufacturer to educate guests about their products in an interactive manner.

The licence would allow for sale and service, in the case of a microbrewery, in quantities not exceeding 341 ml (12 oz), and only between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. on any day.

The AGCO has determined that “By the Glass” applicants are exempt from the usual public advertising process and therefore a municipal resolution indicating support of the local community, is required as part of the application process.

Mr. Robert Black, CEO of Black’s Distillery, has established a craft distillery at 99 Hunter Street East. He has requested Council’s support for his application for a “By the Glass” licence.

Although no formal approvals are required for the By the Glass licence, Mr. Black will still be required to ensure compliance with all applicable zoning requirements, municipal by-laws, the **Building Code Act, 1992**, the **Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997** and the **Health Protection and Promotion Act**.
