In addition, the committee is responsible for reviewing relevant City projects and site plans to promote compliance with the AODA legislation regarding barrier-free accessible buildings. Recommendations arising out of this review process are conveyed to project managers and potential developers and builders, through City staff in various departments including, Planning and Development Services, Utility Services, and Community Services.

A meeting of the Built Environment Sub-Committee was held on Friday, May 20, 2016. The Chair will provide a verbal update to the AAC. Draft minutes of the meeting are appended to this report.
