BIG IDeA

Purpose

Budget and Financial Implications

Background

BIG IDeA brings together business and customers with lived experience of disability and the next generation of business leaders to collaboratively advance accessibility innovation in Ontario as well as creating a culture of accessibility and inclusion.

Inclusive challenges are submitted by users with lived experience that outline specific barriers to inclusion. Then, design challenge events, applied project groups and other initiatives start to develop solutions to the challenges.

Mapping the City of Peterborough (Peterborough) area through inclusive frameworks is also a major focus of BIG IDeA. This will involve volunteer groups visiting local businesses and rating the accessibility, based on predetermined scales and checklists. The information gathered will be uploaded onto digital maps that will provide Peterborough with an inclusive map and inventory of accessibility needs.

Businesses that demonstrate inclusion in their digital and built environments will receive credit through BIG IDeA's developing badge system. Businesses that have accessibility gaps will be provided with resources to assist in the adoption of inclusive practises.

BIG IDeA can only be successful with a community of volunteers, with and without lived experience of disability, and support from local organizations.
