PURPOSE

BACKGROUND

The Accessibility Advisory Committee (AAC) established a Built Environment Sub-Committee to address duties identified in Ontario Regulation 191/11 and Regulation 413/12 found in the **Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005 (AODA)**. The Built Environment Sub-Committee is required to review site plans and drawings a timely manor, as well as to administer the City of Peterborough Access Fund.

Recently, a member of the Built Environment Sub-Committee resigned, therefore leaving a vacancy on the Sub-Committee. The Built Environment Sub-Committee is seeking direction from the AAC regarding how to fill that seat.
