Accessible Parking Concerns at Simcoe Street and George Street

Purpose

A report to the Accessibility Advisory Committee (AAC) recommending the AAC has a follow-up discussion concerning the issue of available accessible parking at George Street and Simcoe Street. This issue was previously discussed at the November 6, 2013, Committee meeting.

Recommendation

That the Accessibility Advisory Committee approves the recommendation outlined in Report AAC14-003 dated January 8, 2014, of the Accessibility Coordinator, as follows:

The Accessibility Advisory Committee review and, provide recommendations to the Transportation Department regarding accessible parking issues at the George Street and Simcoe Street intersection.

Background

The Accessibility Coordinator and the Chair of the AAC Transportation Sub-Committee received feedback from a citizen pertaining to the limited number of accessible parking spaces in front of the Turnbull Medical Building located at the corner of George and Simcoe Street.

This matter was brought forward to the AAC and discussed at the meeting on November 6, 2013. The citizen is requesting that a drop off zone be introduced at the intersection as the accessible parking is often full.

The AAC was asked to visit the intersection to determine if there are any recommendations the Committee would like to make regarding this matter.
