Subject:	Report AAC14-009 AAC Information Brochure

Purpose

A report to promote discussion and seek input from the Accessibility Advisory Committee (AAC) pertaining to the development of an AAC Informational Brochure.

Recommendations

That the Accessibility Advisory Committee approve the recommendations outlined in Report AAC14-009, dated April 2, 2014, of the Accessibility Coordinator as follows:

- a) That Report AAC14-009 with respect to the AAC Information Brochure is received for information, and
- b) That the Committee discuss options and provide input for the brochure.

Budget and Financial Implications

Background

At the January 8, 2014 AAC meeting, the Committee reviewed the priority list which was compiled in the fall of 2013 and it was decided that the next project would be to create an information brochure. The brochure is to be developed by the AAC to educate the public on the accessibility of City of Peterborough facilities.

AAC members were requested to bring ideas pertaining to a brochure to be discussed at the April 2014 meeting.
