Purpose

Background

The Public Works Division upgrades the City's existing play structure inventory based on age, condition, and whether the structure conforms to current Canadian Standards Association (CSA) standards. The play structure at Beavermead Park is more than 15 years old and is showing signs of deterioration. Parts of the structure are missing or do not conform to current CSA guidelines.

Beavermead Park is a Regional Park and is considered to be a destination park because of its amenities. There is an opportunity in the approved 2015 Budget to replace the play structure in Beavermead Park with one that is fully accessible and includes a safety surface.

The Public Works Division is asking the Accessibility Advisory Committee to provide formal comment before the project to replace the Beavermead Park play structure is tendered.
