Green Up's Five-year Capital Funding Campaign for Ecology Park**

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## **Purpose**

A report to inform of Green-Up's five-year capital funding campaign for Ecology Park, through a presentation by the Executive Director of Green Up.

## **Recommendation**

That the Arenas Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee approve the recommendation outlined in Report APRAC17-008 dated March 21, 2017, of the Recreation Division Coordinator, as follows:

That a presentation by Brianna Salmon, Executive Director of Green-Up on Green Up's five-year capital funding campaign required to support their infrastructure requirements for Ecology Park be received.

## **Budget and Financial Implications**

There is no budget or financial implication resulting from the approval of the recommendation of report APRAC17-008.

## Background

On March 21, 2017, the executive Director of Green-up will attend the Arenas Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee meeting to inform of Green Up's infrastructure needs, and related five-year funding plan to complete the necessary capital work.

Specifically, the capital work focuses on the following elements:

- A rebuild of the existing shelter
- Reconstruction of the education and market programming sheds
- Integration of an irrigation system
- A naturalized play space for children
- Development of pathways to key features within Ecology Park
- Installation of solar panels, and a green roof on the shelter
- Construction of a greenhouse

The plan is divided into seven phases, reflecting each element identified above.
