COMMUNITY MEETING – ROGERS COVE WATER PLAY PARK

City Council has approved the addition of a new water play park at Rogers Cove off Maria Street. The project designers, Landscape Planning Limited, have prepared a concept drawing and will be seeking public feedback at a Community Meeting which will take place:

Wednesday, June 20, 2012 – 7:00 p.m. Lions Community Centre – 347 Burnham Street, Peterborough

This initiative was a recommendation from the 2010 Little Lake Master Plan, which created a forward-looking strategy to guide the use of the lake and its adjacent lands. The Rogers Cove project will include construction of:

- an accessible water splash pad;
- a replacement building for the existing portable structure used for washrooms, changing and storage;
- boat storage to support canoe, kayak and sailing activities at Brownsea Base for the Peterborough Scouts;
- connection of the Trans Canada Trail through the park to the rail bridge over the Otonabee River into the downtown;
- a community oven.

Once a design is confirmed, the project will go out for tender and construction will be scheduled for completion in time for the 2013 summer season of operations.
