Subject:	Report APRAC14-027 Correspondence from ORCA – Campground Operations

## Purpose

A report to inform that the City has received a letter from the Otonabee Region Conservation Authority (ORCA), expressing their desire to speak with the City about extending the Beavermead Campground Operating Agreement.

## Recommendation

That the Arenas Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee approve the recommendation outlined in Report APRAC14-027 dated May 27, 2014, of the Recreation Division Coordinator, as follows:

## **Budget and Financial Implications**

There is no budget or financial implication resulting from the approval of the recommendation of report APRAC14-027.

## Background

On February 4, 2013, Council directed that an agreement be entered into with the Otonabee Region Conservation Authority (ORCA) to assume the operation of Beavermead Campground, as a 24-month pilot project, beginning with the 2013 camping season.

On November 19, 2013, John Williams, Manager of Conservation Lands and Resources for the Otonabee Region Conservation Authority made a presentation to APRAC on the outcome of the 2013 Beavermead Campground operation. Mr. Williams' presentation described the 2013 season as being a success.

On April 17, 2014, the ORCA Board of Directors received a report from ORCA staff, summarizing their operation of the Beavermead Campground in 2013. Following a review and discussion of the report, the Board passed a resolution directing ORCA staff to write a letter to the City expressing their desire to extend the Beavermead Campground agreement.

City staff received the letter from ORCA dated May 2, 2014. A copy is attached as Appendix A. City staff will prepare a report to Council, seeking authorization to enter into discussions with ORCA regarding their request to extend the Beavermead Campground operating agreement.
