Steve Terry Way Reconstruction Work

Purpose

A report to inform of reconstructive work to be undertaken on Steve Terry Way and within James Stevenson Park.

Budget and Financial Implications

There is no budget or financial implication resulting from the approval of the recommendation of Report APRAC14-030.

Background

Steve Terry Way, which is situated in James Stevenson Park, was used as the access road to the staging area for heavy equipment and supplies when work on the Hunter Street Bridge was being completed. The staging area was located in the north end of James Stevenson Park. Now that the bridge work is complete, there is a need to undertake reconstructive work to Steve Terry Way and within James Stevenson Park.

The City's Design and Construction Division has issued a tender for the work to be completed in the summer of 2014. The contractor will be required to maintain public access during the course of construction to both Riverside ball diamond and Red Sullivan/East City Bowl ball diamond. Staff felt it important to inform the Arenas Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee of the upcoming work, as the work will begin prior to this committee meeting again in September.
