## Background

In January 2016, Trent University launched an external review of Traill College. The external review of Catharine Parr Traill College has been launched to assess the graduate college's financial viability and potential renewal. The College, located along

London and Dublin Streets just east of Reid, is the University's only remaining campus in the general downtown area.

More recently, Trent also hosted a public information session with City and University staff to present updates on development plans currently underway on the University's Endowment Lands.

Julie Davis, Vice-President of External Relations and Advancement will provide a brief presentation on the two initiatives and seek feedback from the Committee.
