# **Background**

#### Arts, Culture & Heritage Division

#### **Public Art**

- Division staff met with the Corporate Sponsorship Coordinator for an update on the opportunities for obtaining sponsorship of the Downtown Mural project.
- Division staff met with the Chair of the Public Art Advisory Committee (PAAC) to set the agenda for the June meeting.
- Division staff met with the Public Art Coordinator and the AGP Director to review tha Call for the Aylmer and Simcoe Street competition.

#### **Culture Grows Here**

Staff attended the 2017 bi-annual Culture Grows Here – Engaging Communities through the Power of Culture conference held in Midland, Ontario. This was a two day conference put on by the City of Barrie's Creative Economy Department's Culture Branch and Tourism Simcoe County.

The first day was dedicated to the Ontario Public Art Roundtable facilitated by Helena Grdadolnik of WORKSHOP architecture inc. Topics included:

- A review of public art goals and issues how to address issues and achieve goals;
- Canada 150 Projects how to engage community and work with limited budgets;
- Funding successes, opportunities and challenges;
- How to demonstrate value through social, financial and economic development impacts;
- Ways to work with Council and other departments; and,
- Acquisition options and models

The second day focused on the relationship between Culture and Tourism. Sessions included:

- Museum Hack Millenial Audiences;
- "Fresh Made Daily: Culture as a Driver for Leisure Tourism;
- An Experiential Tourism Panel;
- Study Tours; and,
- A presentation by Sans Façon an art practice that responds to the relationship between people and place.

#### **CSD Research Assistant**

Staff participated in interviews for a Department Research Assistant. They will be working on a variety of projects including one for the Municipal Cultural Plan – researching economic indicators for Culture.

#### **Departmental Relocation**

The Department moved to 210 Wolfe Street on Saturday, May 13, 2017 and was open for business on Monday, May 15. All future ACHAC meetings will be held in the Auditorium at 210 Wolfe Street. Parking is available in the parking lot across the street from the building. Parking is not available in the Rehill Parking Lot behind the building. #### 2018 Budget

Staff prepared the 2018 ACH Division budget, and reviewed the Museum, Art Gallery and Heritage Preservation Office budgets. Staff also attended the Community Services Management Software Portfolio review of the IT projects identified for 2018.

### Peterborough Immigration Partnership Coordinating Committee (PIP)

Staff continues participating on the PIP Coordinating Committee and its working groups. The Coordinating Committee oversees the implementation of the PIP 5-year work plan.

Staff also participated in the Outcomes Measurement committee. This committee is developing measures and targets for the 2016-2021 Community Immigrant Integration Plan.

### **Welcome Peterborough MIIO Web Site**

The Ministry funded project to redesign the Portal is reaching its conclusion. Their Division budget includes funding for the ongoing support and maintenance of the web site.
