Budget and Financial Implications

Background

The City of Peterborough is updating its Downtown Parking Management Study last prepared in 2007. The objective of this update is to develop a new five to ten year parking management plan that addresses the Downtown core's new parking needs.

This update is assessing existing and future parking demand to ensure adequate long-term supply is provided, while:

- promoting alternative modes of transportation;
- introducing new state-of-the-art parking technologies; and
- evaluating the financial feasibility of various parking supply types.

The study area is bound by McDonnell Street to the north, Park Street to the west, Rink Street to the south, and the Otonabee River to the east.

Kevin Jones, Transportation Manager will report on the progress of this study.
