Council has adopted a Downtown Master Plan as part of the Official Plan. The Master Plan defines a number of measures to promote Downtown Peterborough's role as a diverse and vibrant component of the City's commercial structure. The image of the downtown has been enhanced in recent years by a combination of public and private investment. Improvements along Charlotte Street, including at the site of the Louis Street Parking Lot, will be the focus of downtown infrastructure projects in the coming years.
