Louis Street Urban Square Update

Purpose

A report to introduce a presentation by Brian Buchardt, Urban Planner, on the status of the Louis Street Urban Park.

Recommendation

Budget and Financial Implications

There are no budgetary or financial implications associated with the recommendation.

Background

At its meeting of August 27, 2012, Council sitting as the Planning Committee approved the use of the Louis Street parking lot for the development of a downtown Urban Park. The development of a public square is one of the key strategies of the Central Area Master Plan, a component of the Official Plan. Council approved funding for the design phase of the project in 2013 and has allocated further funding in the 2014 capital budget.

The Park is envisioned to be sited on an area comprised of the parking lot consolidated with Louis Street to the east and bounded by Charlotte Street on the north and King Street on the south. The plan is part of the larger Charlotte Street Renewal Project from Water Street to Park Street.

Currently the major components of the Park will include:

- a site for the Downtown Farmer's Market
- an area that would serve as a water play area in the warm weather season and a skating rink in the winter
- a performing arts stage with washrooms and storage facilities, and
- space for the installation of public art.

The ACHAC first received a presentation on the project in September of 2010. Brian Buchardt, Planner, Urban Design will provide the ACHAC with an update on the project.
