Background

In May 2015, Trent University will be hosting an international conference on Canadian Studies. Entitled "Contesting Canada's Future" it will engage scholars, thinkers, cultural producers, artists and activists in a three-day, multi-site and multi-format event. It will be an interdisciplinary conference that will be centered at Trent but will extend into additional venues across Peterborough. Professor Eamon is not requesting financial assistance but would like assistance from the Arts, Culture & Heritage community in developing cultural activities for the enjoyment of both conference participants and interested members of the local community.

A first meeting of Interested Peterborough Cultural Organizations was held on April 22, 2014. A topic of discussion was the need to strengthen partnerships between Trent and the greater community as well as between different cultural organizations within the cultural community. A number of suggestions for possible events and presentations were made. They will be discussed in greater detail at future meetings.
