GPA EDC - 2016 Budget

NOTES:

- 1. Core Funding for 2016 is 2% greater than 2015 funding.
- Sustainable Peterborough, a City-County initiative housed within GPA EDC, will receive \$35,000 from the County and \$40,000 from the City in 2016. In 2015 each municipality provided \$35,000 and some unspent funding was carried over from prior years.
- Unspent City funding from 2014 for the Climate Change Action Project, run by Sustainable Peterborough, is being brought into 2015 and 2016 as required.
- 4. The TMAC Conference received \$50,000 from the City and \$25,000 from the County through a 2015 Appendix C request.
- 5. Grant and sponsorship income in 2015 was unusually high due in part to the TMAC Conference which attracted \$40,000 from RTO8. The Shimano cycling signage project also brought in \$24,000 in 2015.
